PROGRAM

Children experience the farm first hand using their 5 senses.

They rotate through five learning stations and enjoy the wonders of a real working farm.

ANIMAL STATION

- Come see and touch our baby animals: ducks, piglets, turkeys, chickens, rabbits, goats, calves, alpaca and lambs.
- Learn about animal needs, how they change as they grow, and how we care for them.

PLANTING STATION

- **In the greenhouse, learn about plants and their needs. Each child will plant 4 seeds to take back to your classroom.**
- **Each child will transplant a small flower (to take home) & learn the parts of a plant & their function.**

NATURE AND BEE STATIONS

- Walk through our bush and see the signs of spring.
- Learn how bees help the farmer and interesting facts about beekeeping
- Taste some farm honey.

WAGON STATION

- ◆ Come on a wagon ride around the farm and see how spring has sprung at Round the Bend Farm.

- ◆ learn about bees and taste some honey

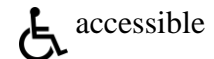

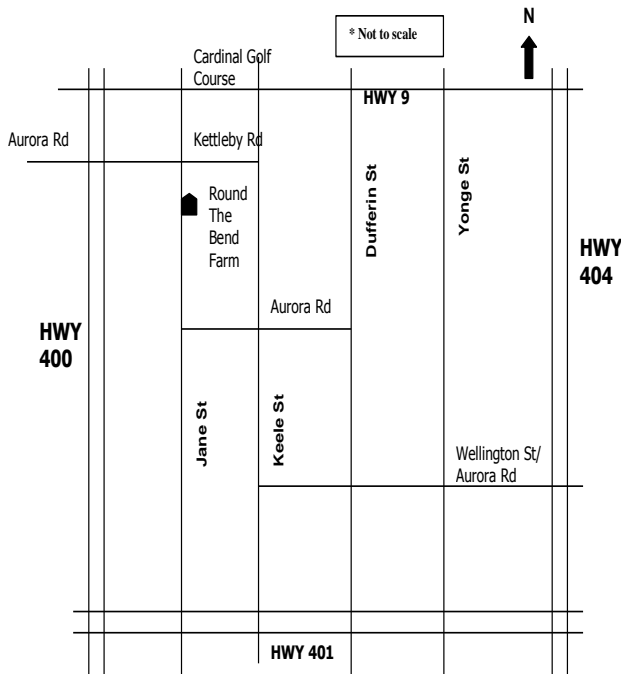
ADULTS:

Directions

- HWY 400N to Lloydtown-Aurora Rd (exit 52)
East 1 km to stop light, right at light.
½ km to farm on left side.

OR

- HWY 404N, west on Wellington St through Aurora to Snowball. North (right) on Dufferin St 2 km. West (left) on Aurora Rd, through round about to stop light. North (right) on Jane St., ½ km to farm, on right.

OR

- From Newmarket, west on HWY 9, south on Jane St., 3 km to stop light. Straight through light, ½ km to farm on east (left) side (3rd place from the lights).

IMPORTANT

Ensure arrival and departure is at the confirmed times. Tours can be modified to best accommodate your time on the farm.



Teachers and parent supervisors are responsible, at all times, for their students while on the farm.

We recommend that supervisors do not take along younger siblings.

Our farm market will be open with asparagus, eggs, honey, oils, jams, pies and more.
